

Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program

Who is eligible to apply?	Persons age 60 and older who are residents of participating counties
What is the benefit amount?	Recipients receive 5 SFMNP (Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program) checks worth \$5 each for a total of \$25.00 that can be used at the participating farmers' markets to purchase product
What are the income limits?	The income is based on total household income at 185% of Federal Poverty Income Limits. (Example: \$1814 for 1 person HH). <u>The checks are issued on a first come first served basis until all are issued.</u>
How is eligibility determined?	Applicants must go to an enrollment site, usually a council on Aging office during the period benefits are being issued and complete an application. Proof of identity and residence in the county at the time of application. <u>Income eligibility is determined by self-declaration.</u>
