 - Briefing: Ms. Hall and Mr. Estep will provide a report from an October 21st meeting of the Regional Transportation Committee. This will include action items regarding proposed amendments to the Regional Transportation improvement Program (TIP) and the Regional Planning Work Program (RPWP). The TIP is a planning document that lists all federally funded transportation projects and studies in the ACOG region. One of the projects in the TIP requires a change in funding allocation based on field review by SCDOT. The RPWP is a biennial document that identifies tasks for transportation planning activities to be undertaken within the ACOG region for the upcoming two-year period. Recently, SCDOT approved an increase in ACOG's annual funding allocation.

- V. <u>Regional Economic Development Committee Report</u> Mr. Don Godbey, Chair, and Ms. Brooke Ferguson, Economic Development Director (Section 5, Board Packet)
 - Briefing: Mr. Godbey and Ms. Ferguson will provide a report from a September 29th meeting of the Economic Development Committee. The report will include action on a request for the establishment of a Special Distressed Area designation for a portion of Anderson and Pickens Counties, in accordance with the SC Textile Communities Revitalization Act. The law provides tax credits for the redevelopment of abandoned textile mills. To be eligible, the property must be located in a distressed area, as designated by the applicable council of governments. Distressed areas were designated by the ACOG Board of Directors in October 2018. In addition, it was decided that the ACOG Board may, at its discretion, designate a special distressed area. A request for such a designation is being made for properties owned by Pacolet Milliken, LLC and located near the intersection of Excelsior Mill Rd & US Hwy 76.
