

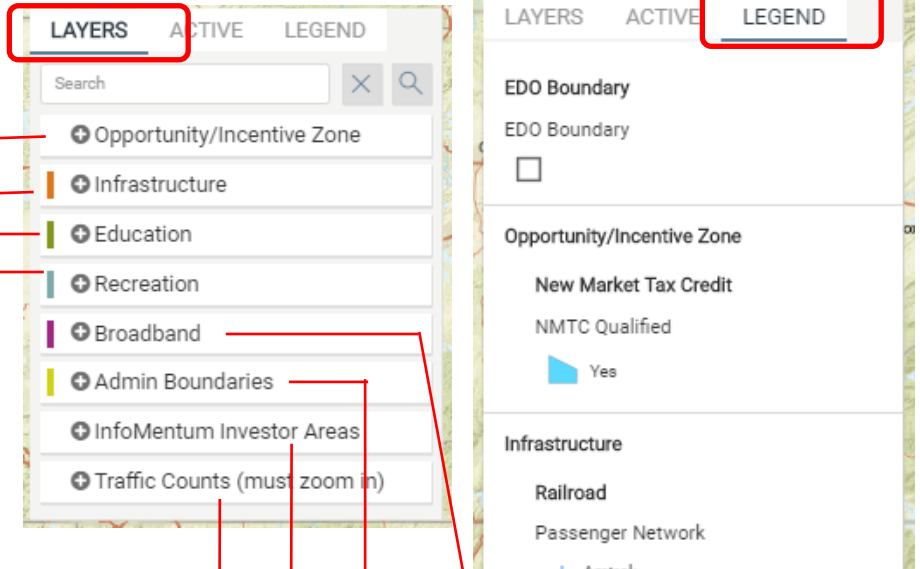
LAYERS

Layers may be added to or removed from the map by checking/unchecking the box to the left of the layer name. A breakdown of current layers by categories is provided below.
