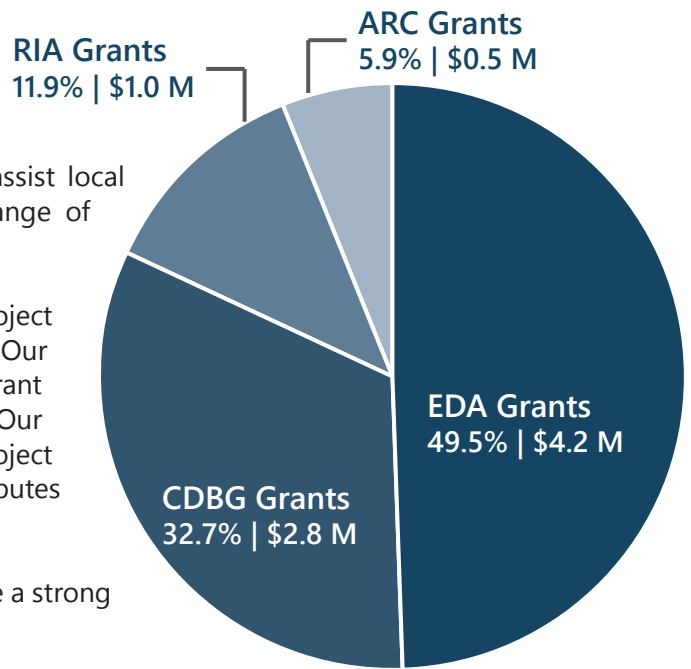


Grants
