Agenda Item II:Amend TIP project US 76 @ Welpine Road to show a cost/funding increasein the Construction phase from \$1,800,000 to \$3,500,000.

Description: SCDOT has been reviewing field conditions for the US 76 @ Welpine Road intersection project in Anderson County. Based on their field review and analysis, modifications to the funding amounts are needed. Since the initial cost estimates were rough, planning-level estimates, it is common for issues to arise in the field that require additional engineering, right-of-way, and construction allocations. Below is a summary of the project and the justification for adjusting the funding levels (see attached map for the location of this project):

US 76 (Clemson Hwy) at S-60 (Welpine Rd) Operational and Safety Project

Proposed Amendment:Increase Construction from \$1,800,000 to \$3,500,000 in FY 2023Justification:After SCDOT field inspections and further study, it was determined
that additional modifications to US 76 are needed as part of this
project, which will improve the intersection's alignment, signalize
the intersection, provides turn lanes on all approaches, and allow
for vehicles to more easily navigate a return to I-85.

Description: In March of 2020, ACOG kicked off the Appalachian Regional Freight Mobility Plan with regional MPO partners in an effort to tackle an issue of regional significance: freight and goods movement.
